

Youth Excellence Program of the Year Award

Deadline: May 31 each year

Purpose

This citation is awarded by the School Library and Youth Services (SLAYS) division of NDLA to a person or persons who exemplifies excellence in library services to youth. This excellence can be demonstrated through one or more of the following: collaborative partnerships; access to technology; information and readers advisory services; education support; programs and services that address special needs or underserved customers; reading promotion; youth participation; intergenerational activities; programs and services that emphasize and promote the library's role in the state, region, local municipality and/or school district.

Nomination Procedure

1. To nominate an individual or group, send a letter of nomination to the SLAYS Chair. NDLA membership is not required to nominate a person(s) for this award.
2. Letters of nomination must include specific reasons for nomination.
